

INFO-PAPIR TIL AIR BNB GÆSTER

Velkommen til København og AB Humlegaarden.

I AB Humlegaarden har vi nogle retningslinjer, som vi håber I vil følge, mens I er her, så vi alle kan bo under samme tag i fred og fordragelighed.

Husreglerne er:

Vi henstiller til, at man begrænser et evt. højt støjniveau i tidsrummet fra kl. 23 – 9, da vi har tynde vægge, og der er meget lyd her.

Husdyr er ikke tilladt, medmindre du/I har lavet en specialaftale med udlejeren.

Vi har affaldssortering på ejendommen (bioaffald og ”almindeligt” affald), og under halvtaget i gården står der containere til de forskellige ting. Se også vedlagte affaldssorteringsguide.

Der er ingen containere til flasker, og lad venligst være med at stille dem under halvtaget. På Sønder Boulevard, der ligger blot et par meter herfra, er der opstillet en flaskecontainer, som I kan benytte.

Det er ikke tilladt at stille skrald og andre effekter af enhver art på køkkentrappen på grund af brandsikkerheden.

INFO PAPER FOR AIR BNB GUESTS

Hi there, and welcome to Copenhagen.

We welcome you in our housing cooperative and to make sure that you feel comfortable during your stay, we have made this info paper to you with all the basic stuff you need to know.

We have some general house orders, which we would like you to respect. They are as follow:

Please keep quiet in the late evening and early morning (from 11 pm to 9 am), as the walls are not well isolated and sound travels easily if one shouts or jumps around.

Pets are not allowed, unless you have made a special agreement with your landlord.

We have a garbage sorting arrangement here, which means you must sort your garbage and allot it in the right containers in the court.

The containers are divided for different purposes: Food leftovers (the biocontainers with the brown lids), paper, cardboard, plastic, daily disposal, etc. On each container you can see what to put in it. See also the enclosed guide to sort your waste.

Note that there are NO containers for bottles/glass, so don't leave them at the containers. At Sønder Boulevard, which is only a few metres from here, there is a big container for bottles and glass on the corner.

It is not allowed to put garbage, big elements etc. on the stairs and kitchen stairs, because of fire hazard.

The tap water in Denmark is very clean, and safe for you to drink.
